Expression of interests are being invited for publication of manuscripts in following areas broadly associated with Humanities/ Social sciences/ Education discipline from the in-house faculties of NSOU in general. However, the topic is not restricted to the area of study mentioned hereunder.

1. Translation work: Novel, Short stories, poetry written by Bengali, English or any Indian writer. (Bengali to English) OR Any Indian language to Bengali.
2. Translation of title published in 19th century Bengal. Copyright free.
3. Research project outcome containing primary source in Book form.
4. Monograph in English or Bengali, based on individual research under taken by the P.I. in the field of Humanities, Social Science, Education or any other related topic.
5. Edited volume will not be accepted.

- **One time grant to the author/translator: Rupees 10,000/- only.**
- **Publication cost will be borne by the CLTCS, School of Humanities.**
- **Copyright reserved by the CLTCS, NSOU for 5years.**
- **Faculty should hold a substantive or contractual position at NSOU.**
- **No. of entry to be selected for F.Y. 2024-25: Two (02)**
- **Manuscripts (in soft copy format) should be submitted within three (03) months from the date of issuance of selection letter.**
- **A memento with certificate of appreciation will be given to the awardee on the day of release of the title.**
- **Any faculty member of NSOU holding substantive/ contractual/ superannuated full time contractual position can apply for the grant.**
- **Last date of submission of proposal: 15th June, 2024**
- **Notification for selection: August, 2024**

Aspiring candidates can submit filled-in application in English or Bengali as attached. A presentation will be arranged on call and selection will be made strictly on the basis of importance / relevance of the texts (manuscripts) and research acumen perceived by the applicant.
